To Obtain a Permit Application

- Students must currently be in Driver Education Classroom or have already completed the course to receive their Parent Approval Form.
- Once the Parent Approval Form is signed and returned to either the Driver Education Teacher or Room 120 in the North Building, the student will receive the permit application.

To Obtain a Driving Permit

- Complete the permit application
- Study the Rules of the Road. (Review Workbook included in the packet or the full version can be downloaded from www.cyberdriveillinois.com)
- Visit the Secretary of State Office (DMV)
 - Pay the \$20 permit fee to the Secretary of States office (Permit will be valid for 24 months).
 - Take and pass Illinois Rules of the Road exam
 - Take and pass a vision exam
 - You are allowed three attempts in order to pass each of the tests.
- If your student fails the Driver Education Classroom their permit may be rescinded and no longer valid.

To Obtain a Driver's License

- Enroll in Behind the Wheel (BTW) instruction.
 - Receive the required minimum of six hours of behind the wheel instruction with a certified instructor.
 - BTW is not a graduation requirement and is not offered to all students during the semester. BTW instruction is chosen by a lottery system when students are taking classroom instruction.
 - May need to be taken privately or through HF Driver Ed Summer School.
- Hold your permit at least nine months.
- Complete a minimum 50 hours of behind the wheel experience.
 - The 50 hours must be under the supervision of a responsible adult 21 or older.
 The adult must have a valid driver's license and at least one year of driving experience.
 - Of the 50 hours, students are required to get 10 hours from driving at night.
- If you choose to not enroll in Behind the Wheel instruction you must wait until you are 18
 years old to receive your license and bring proof of taking and passing the Driver
 Education classroom to the DMV.
